Step 1 - Create!

Sort out Clothes; Shoes and Accessories; Ornaments; Pictures; Curtains; Household Textiles; Books, CDs, Games, Jewellery and Unwanted Gifts that you no longer have use for and place them in bags or boxes for Hospice.

Any clothing or textiles which are in poor condition can be placed in separate bags clearly marked for recycling. The great news is that we can make extra money from these donations by selling them as rags. (The Acid Test, 'would you buy it yourself?')



Step 2 - Donate!

Bring all your items to the drop off point at the GPS reception between 13th - 17th September.

Did You Know - By donating clothes, you will generate an average of £20 per bag (that's £2,500 / tonne) ...Leaving stock on your doorstep in response to one of the many bag drops, will usually only raise 35p per bag (that's £50 / tonne) for the relevant charity. Which would you prefer?



Step 3 - Congratulate!
