



2010 Calendar Competition

The theme of our 2010 calendar is **'Beauty in Nature'** and we are looking for you to submit your photographs which capture the beauty of the natural world.

The best 12 photographs will take pride of place in the GPS Calendar 2010, along with the winner's company logo and/or acknowledgement. Each winner will also receive 250 Christmas cards featuring their winning photograph on the front of the card.

The **competition closes on Friday 31st July 2009.**

Competition rules

1. The subject for the GPS Calendar Photographic Competition 2010 is 'Beauty in Nature'. The theme is open to individual interpretation but entries must have the natural world at their heart. Photographs of animals in captivity (such as zoos/safari parks) are not eligible.
2. Entrants can submit electronic images in colour or black and white. Prints or slides, cannot be accepted.
3. Each entry should be marked with name, address, contact telephone number and where the photo was taken.
4. Images may need cropped to suit the layout of the calendar.
5. Entries should be sent in Jpeg format to: **competition@gpscolour.co.uk**
6. The competition closes at midnight on Friday 31 July 2009.
7. All entries will be judged by a panel of judges and they will choose the winning photos. Their decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
8. The prize is as stated. The Christmas cards will be FSC and Carbon Neutral, printed in full colour on 350gsm silk and will contain a message of the winner's choice. There is no cash alternative and the prize cannot be sold or transferred.
9. All entries must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe the rights of any other party. The entrants must be the sole owner of copyright in all photographs entered and must have obtained permission of any people featured in the entries or their parents/guardians if children under 16 are featured. Further, entrants must not have breached any laws when taking their photographs.
10. GPS retains the right to free reproduction and exhibition of all entries. By sending a photo to us, you grant us permission to publish your photo, or any part of it, in any media we choose, including our website. No payment will be made for the use of your photo.
